- (1) in the case of the entry of the name of a person\*- upon the commercial register, register of associations, register of cooperatives, or ship register, that such person's property has not been blocked by Military Government and that the person has not at
  - ◆ any time been "actively engaged in anj of the activities of the Nazi Party or of its affiliated organizations", as such phrase is defined in section 4 (a);
- (2) in the case of an entry concerning or affecting property, that such entry and the transaction underlying it will neither transfer any right in or title to, or possession of, property from any person whose property has been blocked by Military Government nor reduce or impair the value of such property.
- (d) (1) No entry made upon the land register, the commercial register, or any other public register maintained by a judge or other official of the administration of justice between<sup>^</sup> the date on which the land registry office (Grundbuchamt) and general register department (Abteilung für Registersachen) were closed as required by Military Government and the date of commencement of operations under this regulation shall have any legal effect unless and until there is added to it by the official in charge of such register a notice of confirmation.
  - (2) A notice of confirmation shall be added as of course to every entry of the kind described in subsection (a).  $^{3}$
  - (3) A notice of confirmation shall not be added to an entry of the kinds described in subsections (b) and (c) unless the official in charge finds and certifies as part of his official action that the requirements of such applicable subsection have been satisfied. In the meantime, such entry shall be conspicuously marked "Suspended" and notice of such suspension and of the requirements of this entire section and section 7 shall be mailed to the last known address of, or lawfully served on, the person or persons interested in maintaining such entry.
