**Law No. 3 \*)**

DEFINITION OF UNITED NATIONS

1. The expression "United Nations" as used in Proclamations, Laws, Ordinances, Notices and Orders of the Military Government shall, in the absence of indication to the contrary, mean nations which are signatories of the United Nations Declaration dated January 1, 1942, and nations associated with them in this war, including:
