ARTICLE III

Censorship

- 8. All correspondence, personal papers and documents transmitted by post and all communications by telephone, teletype, telegraph or radio (when the respective services are restored) must conform with the Military Government censorship regulations and must only be transmitted through authorized channels. All correspondence, personal papers and documents carried by civilian travellers are equally subject to censorship.
- 9. The effective regulations as from the date of this Law are the "CENSORSHIP REGULATIONS FOR THE CIVILIAN POPULATION OF GERMANY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MILITARY GOVERNMENT" (copies of which, insofar as possible, are to be displayed in every post office and to be published in the Military Government Gazette). These regulations may be extended and amended from time to time.
- 10. All officials and employees of the Reichspost will take all practicable steps to ensure that censorship requirements are fully met and that there is no eyasion of censorship.

ARTICLE IV

Penalties

11. Any person violating any provision of this Law shall, upon conviction by Military Government Court, be liable to any lawful punisAient, including death, as the Court may determine.

ARTICI F V:

Effective Date

12. This Amended Law shall become effective upon the date of its first promulgation.
