**Information Control Regulation No. 1\***

CONTROL OF PUBLICATIONS, RADIO, BROADCASTING, FILMS,  
THEATRES AND MUSIC

1. This Regulation sets, forth the conditions under which certain of the activities prohibited by' Law No. 191 Amended (1) may take place.

2. No person shall conduct any of the following activities except under a license granted to him by Military Government ©and in accordance with the provisions of such license and Military Government Regulations and Instructions:

(a) Publishing of newspapers, magazines, periodicals, books, posters, pamphlets, printed music and other publications.

Q (b) Operation of a news service, news or photographic agency, radio broadcasting or television station or system, wired radio transmission or audio-frequency distribution system.

(c) Production of a film or sound recording, or the production or presentation of any play, concert, opera, fair, circus, carnival or other performance using actors or musicians.

3. Any person who complies with the conditions in Section 4 of this Regulation, and who is not otherwise prohibited by Military Government, is hereby granted permission to conduct the following activities:

(a) Distributing, selling or lending commercially newspapers, magazines, periodicals, books, pamphlets, posters, printed music and # other publications.

(b) Printing of newspapers, magazines, periodicals, books, posters, , pamphlets, printed music and other publications for licensed publishers thereof.

(c) Providing to licensed producers the facilities of theatres, concert halls, opera houses, outdoor stadia and other places of public entertainment.

(d) Distributing or exhibiting approved films, provided that a Film \* Exhibition Certificate ^s annexed to each print distributed or exhibited, and that in the case of a distributor, he has been approved by a District Information Control Unit.
