3. No film will be removed, once it has impounded, except on instructions from District' Information Control Units!

BY ORDER OF MILITARY GOVERNMENT

MILITARY GOVERNMENT — GERMANY SUPREME COMMANDER'S AREA OF CONTROL

Information Control Instruction No. 1

To persons engaging in information activities in accordance with sections 3, 4 and 5 of Information Control Regulation No. 1.

Any person engaging in the activities set forth in Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Information Control Regulation No. 1, and not otherwise prohibited by Military Government, shall conduct such activities in accordance with the conditions specified in Information Control Regulation No. 1 and the following instructions.

1. Distribution of publications, music in printed form, sound recordings

It is prohibited to sell,, lend or distribute any newspaper, book, pamphlet, periodical, poster or other publication, or any music in printed form, or any sound recording which:

- (a) Propagates National socialist or related "völkisch" ideas including racism and race hatred.
- (b) Propagate Fascist or anti-democratic ideas.
- (c) Attempts to create divisions between, or foster disrespect for, the United Nations.
- (d) Propagate militaristic ideas, including Pan-Germanism and German imperialism.
- (e) Cpnstitutes an incitement to riot or disorder, or interferes in any way with the process of Military Government.
