

(e) Handbills and posters published in accordance with this paragraph will not contain:

1. News — local or international. 2. Advertising.

(f) Each Handbill or poster published will clearly show the party sponsoring it, the specific individual or individuals in the party assuming responsibility for its publication, the address of the individual or individuals concerned, the printer producing it, and the number of copies printed.

2. Authorized political parties wishing to publish magazines, books,* pamphlets, or other publications for which license is not granted in paragraph 1 will appoint a representative or representatives to be responsible for such literature. Such representative or representatives may apply to the information control unit concerned for a license to publish under the provisions of information control regulation No. 1.

3. An authorized political party *is a German political party which has been given permission by Military Government to be active in a given area.

4. For violation of any of the foregoing conditions a party's license to publish handbills and posters may b[^] suspendend or revoked, and the person or persons responsible for the publishing activities of the party will be subject to such other penalties as a Military government Court

MILITARY GOVERNMENT—GERMANY SUPREME COMMANDER'S 'AREA OF CONTROL

INSTRUCTIONS TO CHIEFS OF GERMAN POLICE AGENCIES

1. You will maintain law and order and enforce any ordinances, regulations and orders issued under the authority of the United Nations.

2. You will not enforce or permit to be enforced any German laws, rules or regulaltons that are in any manner prejudicial to the Military Forces or are abrogated by any Military Proclamations, Ordinances or Orders, but you will continue to enforce all other German laws.
