

4. The Deputy Military Governor shall appoint a court within thirty (30) days from the promulgation of The court will thereupon be authorized and constituted such. Other members of the court may be appointed Military Governor as the business of the court may requi

5. Cases will ordinarily be heard by one judge, a president, but the full court or two members, thereof shall when the president so directs. The member or membe sitting in a particular case shall render decision thereon, of the court not participating in the hearing or trial shall in the decision or judgment.

6. The president of the court shall appoint a clerk, a stenographer, who will be stationed at the offices of the co Members of the court and the clerk shall not be assign functions in Military Government and shall give their business of the court. Deputy clerks, deputy marshals, cc preters and other employees may be appointed by the presi as the business of the court may require from time to tiim the marshal and other employees shall serve at the pleas no tenure for such services being hereby established.

7. The jurisdiction of the court is limited to civil acti arising out of the operation of motor vehicles not owne States Government.

8. The event giving rise to a cause of action must hav* the territorial limits of the United States Zon§, the United Berlin or Bremen Enclave.

9. One or more parties to the action must belong following groups:

- (a) Personnel of the United States Army;
- (b) Civilian United States nationals subject to militi
- (c) Civilian United States nationals not subject to
- (d) Visiting/ nationals of United Nations.
