- 4. No former member or employee of this armed forces of the United States or former employee of the Office of Military Government of the United States shall be permitted to testify before a German court concerning any information acquired by him as the result of such membership or employment of which involves the activities of the armed forces or of the Military Government or its personnel, unless expressly permitted to do so in writing by the Commanding Officer of the unit of which he was a member or at which he was employed, or, if the testimony concerns the Office of Military Government of the United States, then by the Director of the Office of Military Government for the Land in which such German court is situated.
- 5. No person subject to the United States military law, and no employee of the Office of Military Government of the United States, other than a German national, shall be subject to punishment by any German court for any contempt for such court, but such contempt may be referred by the court before which the testimony was requested to the appropriate approving authority mentioned above for appropriate action.
