

2. No action shall be taken or permitted, to alter enlarge or change ownership, access privileges, or agencies relating to articles left for safekeeping or safe deposit boxes in financial institutions, hotels or other similar safe deposit agencies in the U.S. Zone in Germany.

3. Every person who owns, rents or has power of attorney or access to any safe deposit box, article or package left for safekeeping must fill out a Fragebogen at once and deliver it to the management of the place where he has the safe deposit. Every such person whose property is not blocked under Military Government law must present himself or send his authorized representative between 15 September and 15 October 1945, at the particular time directed, to the financial institutions, hotel or safekeeping office where he has a safe deposit, or any articles left for safekeeping, for the purpose of opening such safe deposit and disclosing its contents. Each such person must inquire and find out the exact date on which he will be allowed to open his safe deposit box or package. Fragebogen must be completed and delivered to the place of safe deposit before access will be granted.

4. If one of the persons having access to or ownership of any article in any such deposit is a person whose property is blocked, or is in the category of blocked persons under Military Government Law No. 52, General Order No. 1 thereunder, or Instructions to Financial Institutions, No. 3 (Personnel) as revised, then nobody may have access to the safe deposit except as provided in paragraph 5 below. Persons not blocked and having safe deposit boxes or articles in safekeeping who do not present themselves before 15 October 1945, as mentioned above, will forfeit the right of access to their safe deposits. Their safe deposit boxes and articles left y dor safekeeping will be opened and examined by Military Government and be treated as required by all Military Government laws, especially Nos. 52 and 53.

5. All person's whose property is blocked pursuant to Military Government Law No. 52, General Order No. 1, or otherwise, must present/themselves or have their authorized representatives present themselves, as directed, between 16 October and 15. November 1945 at the place where
