

they have a safe deposit box or any article left for safekeeping. Each such person must find out the exact date or dates on which he must present himself. Persons in detention will deliver their keys to Military Government or designate, in writing, a representative to appear for them with such keys and their Fragebogen.

6. Failure to comply with these instructions will render the persons violating them liable to the pertinent penalties provided by Military Government laws and ordinances.

7. This notice is effective 5 September 1945.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE AND EXTERNAL ASSETS

φ 1. The attention of all persons is drawn to Military Government Law No. 53 and to the absolute necessity of declaring and delivering forthwith all property referred to Articles II and III respectively of that Law.

2. Property must be declared even though it may have become legally vested in the German External Property Commission by virtue of Control Council Law No. 5

3. Any person who fails after the expiry of thirty days from the date of this notice to declare or deliver any property affected, upon conviction by a Military Government court, shall be liable to further severe penalties as the court may determine in addition to any outstanding penalty under Law No. 53.

4. This notice becomes effective 10 February 1946.
