FRONTIER CONTROL

Military Government Law No. 161 is amended to read as follows:

1. Except as authorized by Military Government, no person shall cross the frontiers of Germany and no civilian shall cross the boundaries, of the U.S. Zone. Except as so authorized, all inward and outward movement of property and goods either across said frontier or zonal boundary is also prohibited.

2. The frontiers of Germany as referred to in this Law are such frontiers as they existed on 31 Dezember 1937.

3. Any persons violating the provisions of this Law shall, upon conviction by Military Government Court, be liable to any lawful punishment including death, as the Court may determine.

4. This Law becomes effective 1 December 1945.
