A survey is given how in the operation of the agencies of the administration of justice the complex fight against offences increases and how the experiences and knowledge won by these agencies serve the improvement of law.

The partly isolated treatment of question concerning lawfulness does not meet the demands of the developed system of socialism. The authors suggest that still visible contradictions and deficiencies in our legal order are a grave obstacle for the prevention of criminality.
