ARTICLE 5: MEMBERSHIP

(**D** Membership in the Organization shall be open to any State which is a member of any of the Unions as defined in Article 2(Vii).

(2) Membership in the Organization shall be equally open to any State not a member of any of the Unions, pi'ovided that:

- (i) it is a member of the United Nations, any of the Specialized Agencies brought into relationship) with the United Nations, or the International Atomic Energy Agency, or is a party to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, or
 - (U) it is invited by the General Assembly to become a party to this Convention*

ARTICLE 6; GENERAL ASSEMBLY

(DU) There shall be a General Assembly' cousiati::** of the States party to this Convention .which are members of any of the Unions*

(b) The Government of each State shall be represented by one delegate, who may be assisted by alternate delegates, advisors,¹ and exports.

(c) The expenses of each delegation shall bo borne by the Government which lias appointed it.

- (2) The General Assembly shall:
 - (i) appoint the Director General upon nomination by the Coordination Committee;
