ARTICLE 9:. INTERNATIONAL BUREAU

- (l) 'The International Bureau shall be the Secretariat of the Organization.
- (2) The International Eureau shall be directed by the Birector General, assisted by two or more Deputy Directors General.
- (3) The Director General shall be appointed Γ or Γ . fixed term, which, shall be not Jess than six! years. JIo shall be eligible Γ or reappointment Γ or fixed terms. The periods of the initial appointment and possible subsequent appointments, as veil as all other conditions of the appointment, shall be fixed by the General Assembly.
- (^)(a) The Director General shall be the chief cxe.ctt*» tive of the Organization.

- (c) He shall report to, and conform to the instructions of, the General Assembly as to the internal and external affairs, of the Organization,
- (5) The Director General shall prepare the draft programs and budgets and periodical reports on activities# He shall transmit them to the Governments of the interested Sta-tes and to the competent ox'gans of the Unions and the Organization,
- (6) The Director General and any staff member •'desig'natcel by him-shall participate, without the right to vote,
 in all meetings of the General Assembly, the Conference,
 the Coordination Committee, and any other committee or
 working group. The Director General br a staff member
 designated by him shall be ex officio secretary of these
 bodies,
- (7) .The Director General shall appoint the staff necessary for the efficient performance of tho. tasks of the International Bureau. -He shall appoint the Deputy
